“Accidental Artist”

When you design quilts as you go, you embrace serendipity and become an “accidental artist”. Learn several methods of creating fused quilt designs in an improvisational manner. Begin with a heap of pre-fused fabric scraps from Laura’s stash to trigger your design ideas. Learn various systems for constructing your artwork and put your colorful fabric kit to good use. You’ll create and learn as you go. It’s fun to design on the fly!

\$25 Kit Fee: Includes hand out, pre-fused scraps, hand-dyed fabrics and threads, and a needle. (Paid to Laura on day of workshop.)

Supplies Participants Should Bring:

- 2 yards of regular weight Wonder-Under fusible web (paper backed #805). Please DO NOT BRING Heat ‘n Bond or Steam a Seam
- 1 yard of parchment paper
- Sharp scissors like small 5 knife blade scissors
- Paper scissors
- Rotary cutters, ruler, and mat
- Specialty blades, like Pinking, Wavy, or Scallop (optional)
- Batting, 1 piece measuring about 18” x 18
- Quilt backing fabric, 1 piece measuring about 18” x 18
- Iron and ironing surface (if not provided by group)
- Thimble (optional)
- Small plastic bag for fabric scraps
- Tweezers (optional).

Evergreen Quilters Guild Workshop Policies

A member is considered registered for a workshop/class when fees are paid. In the event there is a great deal of interest in a class, those who pay the fee are registered first and guaranteed a spot in the class.

Classes/workshops will be opened up to non-members one month prior to the class. A \$20 surcharge, in addition to the class fee, is charged for a non-member to attend a workshop/class.

Whenever Evergreen Quilters Guild splits expenses with a neighboring guild, that guild’s members will qualify for the Evergreen Quilters Guild member fee for the class.

If a registered and paid member must withdraw from an Evergreen Quilters Guild class, the following applies: If it is more than sixty days before the class, the member will receive a full refund from the Evergreen Quilters Guild Treasurer. If within fifty-nine days of the class, no refund is issued. A member can find a replacement for the class on her own and any financial arrangements are between the two members.
