“Sunrise OR Sunset Contemporary Landscape” November 13, 2019 9 am to 3:30 pm

By making random cuts to your batik scraps and placing them on fused batting, you will become the artist to create a contemporary “watercolor” look of either a Sunrise OR a Sunset. Your landscape will be finished by many rows of top stitching to give more texture and dimension to the landscape. A focal point is later added for interest and clarity to your landscape. Instructions on doing a knife edge binding will be included at days end. **The finished size of your landscape will be approximately 12”x 22”.** This is a fun class to give you confidence in working without rulers and no pattern!

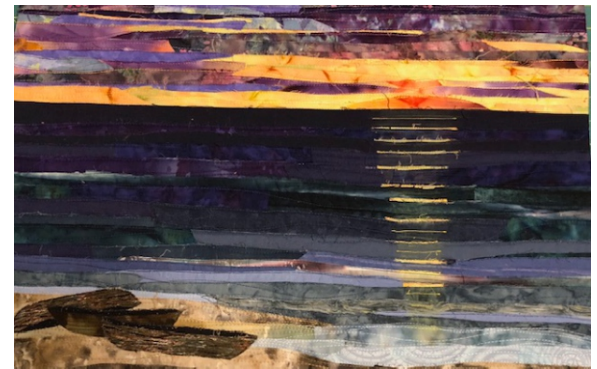
A \$15 kit fee payable to the instructor on the day of the workshop will include:

- 1 yard 18” wide Lite Steam A Seam 2 (enough for 2 landscapes)
- Batting 16” x 26” piece
- Glue stick suitable for fabric
- Printed instructions / diagrams
- Access to my personal batik scrap stash to augment your batiks

Workshop Supplies brought by participant:

Batik scraps in your choice of colors that depict Sunrise or Sunset colors. Search internet for images of colors used, include lights, mediums, and darks to give depth in landscape.

- Rotary cutter and small mat
- Small fabric scissors
- 1/2 yard backing fabric (does NOT need to be batik)
- Ruler for squaring up and cutting binding strips
- Top stitching threads that blend with batik colors. (Solids or Variegated)
- Sewing machine with walking foot (if your machine requires it to quilt layers),
- Standard pressure foot, free motion foot
- Size 14 topstitch needles, hand sewing needles, quilt pins
- Optional: fabric tweezers

Evergreen Quilters Guild Workshop Policies

A member is considered registered for a workshop/class when fees are paid. In the event there is a great deal of interest in a class, those who pay the fee are registered first and guaranteed a spot in the class.

Classes/workshops will be opened up to non-members one month prior to the class. A \$20 surcharge, in addition to the class fee, is charged for a non-member to attend a workshop/class.

Whenever Evergreen Quilters Guild splits expenses with a neighboring guild, that guild's members will qualify for the Evergreen Quilters Guild member fee for the class.

If a registered and paid member must withdraw from an Evergreen Quilters Guild class, the following applies: If it is more than sixty days before the class, the member will receive a full refund from the Evergreen Quilters Guild Treasurer. If within fifty-nine days of the class, no refund is issued. A member can find a replacement for the class on her own and any financial arrangements are between the two members.
