Kit Fee \$50, includes cork fabric, stabilizers and closures and pattern

The tote finishes about 16 ½” wide x 12” tall x 4” deep

Supply List

1/3 yard (or two fat quarters) Fabric 1 for the Bag top, small pocket

½ yard (or two fat quarters) Fabric 2 for the small accent band, lining, pocket lining

1/3 yard (or two fat quarters) Fabric 3 for the middle accent and large pockets

Notions:

Sewing Machine in good working order

Basic sewing supplies, including rotary cutter, ruler and mat

Thread to match for top stitching

Microtex Needle size 90/14

Clips/Pins

Bring leftover fabric to class!

BEFORE CLASS:

From Fabric 1 cut:

Two 8” x 18” rectangles, label “Piece A” (bag top)

Two 3” x 18” rectangles (small pocket)

From Fabric 2 cut:

Two 14” x 17” rectangles (lining)

Two 1” x 18” strips, label “Piece B” (small front accent)

Two 3” x 18” rectangles (small pocket lining)

From Fabric 3 cut:

Two 1 ½” x 18” strips, label “Piece C” (middle front accent)

Two 9 ½” x 17 rectangles (large pockets)

Evergreen Quilters Guild Workshop Policies

A member is considered registered for a workshop/class when fees are paid. In the event there is a great deal of interest in a class, those who pay the fee are registered first and guaranteed a spot in the class.

Classes/workshops will be opened up to non-members one month prior to the class. A \$20 surcharge, in addition to the class fee, is charged for a non-member to attend a workshop/class.

Whenever Evergreen Quilters Guild splits expenses with a neighboring guild, that guild's members will qualify for the Evergreen Quilters Guild member fee for the class.

If a registered and paid member must withdraw from an Evergreen Quilters Guild class, the following applies: If it is more than sixty days before the class, the member will receive a full refund from the Evergreen Quilters Guild Treasurer. If within fifty-nine days of the class, no refund is issued. A member can find a replacement for the class on her own and any financial arrangements are between the two members.
