“Sew on the Go -Castle Wall Block” Supply List

- *Required Kit: \$25.00 includes the following
 - set of acrylic templates for 9” Castle Wall Block (retail price \$25)
 - spool of 50wt Aurifil Thread
 - Hemming #11 Milliners Needle and various pins
 - Use of various marking pens
- *if you own the templates then remainder of the kit is \$5



STUDENTS WILL NEED TO BRING:

- Thimble – If you don’t have one I will have a possible solution for you
- Scissors for fabric cutting – will want a blade at least 5-6” in length
- Scissors for thread snipping- short blade
- Pencil & handheld sharpener
- Two Gel Pens/White or Yellow and Silver or Med. Blue
 - I recommend Sakura pens that can be found in the scrapbooking area of your local craft store.
- Clover Table Top Needle Threader – if you have one bring it
- A portable OTT light - if you have one



FABRIC:

- Five fabrics are needed to make a block.
- Please bring at least a 10” square equivalent of each fabric.
- I highly suggest bringing at least 7-10 fabrics to allow for creativity.

Evergreen Quilters Guild Workshop Policies

A member is considered registered for a workshop/class when fees are paid. In the event there is a great deal of interest in a class, those who pay the fee are registered first and guaranteed a spot in the class.

Classes/workshops will be opened up to non-members one month prior to the class. A \$20 surcharge, in addition to the class fee, is charged for a non-member to attend a workshop/class.

Whenever Evergreen Quilters Guild splits expenses with a neighboring guild, that guild’s members will qualify for the Evergreen Quilters Guild member fee for the class.

If a registered and paid member must withdraw from an Evergreen Quilters Guild class, the following applies: If it is more than sixty days before the class, the member will receive a full refund from the Evergreen Quilters Guild Treasurer. If within fifty-nine days of the class, no refund is issued. A member can find a replacement for the class on her own and any financial arrangements are between the two members.
