Large (L)—Constructed and Quilted by only one person.

Dimensions – Widths 54 inches or greater

- L-1 Handmade (all techniques), hand quilted
- L-2 Combined techniques (hand & machine), hand quilted
- L-3 Machine pieced, hand quilted
- L-4 Machine pieced, non longarm machine quilted
- L-5 Combined techniques (hand & machine), non long arm machine quilted
- L-6 All techniques, long arm quilted, w/out computer assist
- L-7 All techniques, long arm quilted, computer assisted
- L-8 Other

Medium (M) – Constructed and Quilted by only one person.

Dimensions – Widths 36 inches-53 inches

- M-1 Handmade (all techniques), hand quilted
- M-2 Combined techniques (hand & machine), hand quilted
- M-3 Machine pieced, hand quilted
- M-4 Machine pieced, machine quilted

Two-Person Quilt (TP) – Constructed by one person and quilted by another person.

- TP-1 Handmade (all techniques) hand quilted
- TP-2 Combined techniques (hand & machine) hand quilted
- TP-3 Machine pieced, hand quilted
- TP-4 Machine pieced, machine quilted
- TP-5 Combined techniques (hand & machine), non longarm machine quilted
- TP-6 All techniques, long arm quilted, w/out computer assist
- TP-7 All techniques, long arm quilted, computer assisted
- TP-8 Miniature
- TP-9 Art – original works created by one person and quilted by another
- TP-10 Other

Note: All quilts in the Art categories must be original works created by and quilted by the same person (no kits or patterns).

Art

- A-1 **Landscape/Still Life**- The main focus is realistic scenery or groupings of people, animals, objects or plant life.
Examples: woodland scene, fruit in a bowl, flower garden, view through a window, etc.
- A-2 **Figurative/Portrait**- The main focus is a single, recognizable, figure-such as a person or animal.
Examples: self-portrait, one dog, woman in the woods, (with the focus being the woman, not the woods), etc.
- A-3 **Surreal/Fantasy**- The main focus is a recognizable but unrealistic object, person or setting. Think imagination, dream world and fantasy. Examples: moon wearing glasses, floating people, flying car, pig reading a book, etc.
- A-4 **Abstract**- Art that does not attempt to represent external, recognizable reality, but seeks to achieve its effect using shapes, forms, colors, textures and geometrics.
- A-5 **Other**

Modern (MN)- Primarily functional and inspired by modern design. Characteristics include, but are not limited to: the use of bold colors and prints, high contrast and graphic areas of solid color, improvisational piecing, minimalism, expansive negative space, and alternate grid work.

- MN-1 All techniques constructed and quilted by only one person.
- MN-2 All techniques constructed and quilted by more than one person.

Group Quilt - All techniques – Made by 3 or more people.

- G-1 Other
- G-2 Art

Block of Month/Kit (BK-1) All techniques – Items made from Block of the Month or Kits – Narrative should describe any modifications made.

- Youth/up to 16 yrs (Y-1)** All techniques (Note: this category gets a judges critique form and gets a Youth Ribbon)
- Clothing (CG-1)** All techniques
- Furnishings (F-1)** All techniques– Examples: pillows, dolls, holiday items, etc.
- First Endeavor (FE)** All techniques (Note: this category gets a judges critique form and gets a First Endeavor Ribbon)
- Non-Judged (NJ)** All techniques
