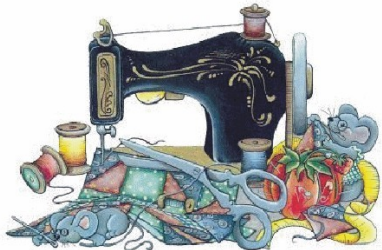

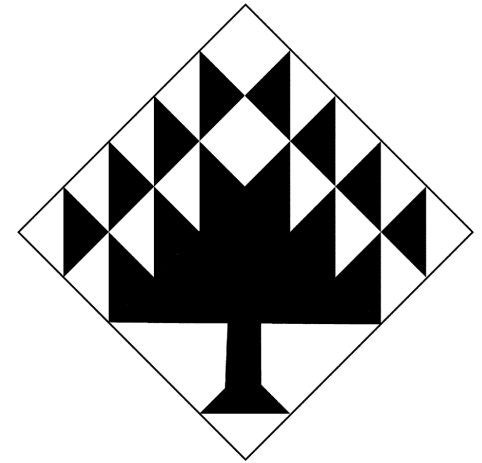

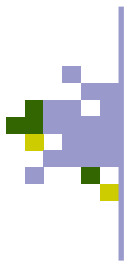

Membership

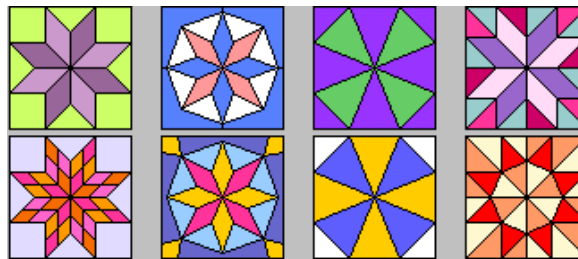

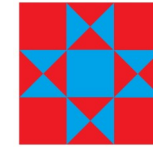

Community Service Projects

Comfort Quilts The lap size quilts go to St. Vincent Hospital (30"x30" or 45"x 60"), Bellin Hospital Pediatric Wards (36"x40" or 45"x 60"), and Foster the Village (for kids ages birth to 18). The quilts are placed on the beds to welcome children to the room with color to comfort them in a difficult situation, and help them feel more secure.

Service Quilts Service quilts are twin size (60 x 80 inches). Members make the tops and then they are either tied or long arm quilted. The quilts are donated to homeless shelters, Golden House, and other charities.

Soldier Quilts The guild makes quilts for wounded soldiers of Wisconsin. They are then distributed to our veterans at the Fisher House in Milwaukee. These quilts are (60"x80" or 72"x 90").

Hospice Quilt This is a 36" x 36" or 36" x 40" wheelchair quilt for wrapping around a person's lap to keep them warm. These quilts go to Aurora Hospice.

Pillowcases are made for St. Vincent Hospital Pediatrics, Bellin Health Child Life, and Foster the Village.

Placemats (12" x 18) bring greater cheer to those receiving Meals on Wheel.

Cancer Hats are to comfort those who lose their hair through the treatment of cancer.
