Two Ways to Submit Your Quilt Entry

Online:

- Go online to:

- Fill out the form online.
- Fees will be paid by mailing a check to Stacy Brault (see address to right). Make out to "Evergreen Quilters Guild." NOTE: We will not be paying fees online as in past years due to new PayPal regulations.
- Online entry fees:
 - Guild Member - \$8.00 per quilt entry
 - Non-Guild Member - \$10.00 per quilt entry
 - 16 years and Younger - \$5.00 per quilt entry

Through the US Postal Mail:

- Fill out the Quilt Registration form and mail to:

- Mail in fees:
 - Guild Member - \$8.00 per quilt entry
 - Non-Guild Member - \$10.00 per quilt entry
 - 16 years and Younger - \$5.00 per quilt entry

Deadlines:

- Mailed entry forms with fees: Postmarked on or before March 14, 2026.
- Online entry forms: Filled out by March 14, 2026 and mail checks.
- In Person Delivery:
Wednesday, April 15, 2026: 5:00 pm – 7:00 pm
Green Bay Community Church (Front Entrance): 600 Cardinal Ln, Green Bay, WI
- Shipped Quilts: Must arrive on or before April 10, 2026 at Sue Lemery's home (315 Dworak Ave., Denmark, WI 54208). If you are not picking up your entries after the show, you must supply return UPS shipping & insurance fees, a self-addressed mailing label, packaging, and a sturdy box.

Judges' Tour:

- Judges' Tour starts promptly at 8:30 am on Friday, April 17, 2026. You will receive one ticket per quilter for the Judges' Tour (regardless of the number of quilt entries). You need to show your ticket for admission to the Judges' Tour.

Awards:

- 1st, 2nd, 3rd place and Honorable Mention Ribbons
- Additional Awards:
 - Best of Show, Best Hand Quilting, Best Stationary Machine Quilting, Best Longarm Quilting – Hand Guided, Best Longarm Quilting – Computer Guided, Creativity, Viewer's Choice, Quilt Show Chair (2 ribbons), and Judge's Choice (2 ribbons)

Pick-up After Show:

- Starting at 4:00 pm, all entries must be claimed by an authorized person at the claim area on Saturday, April 18, 2026. Judged quilts will be accompanied by the judge's written critique. NOTE: Claim tickets are required to pick up a quilt.

Other Requirements and Information:

- The Quilt Show Committee classifies entries and reserves the right to reject any quilts that are soiled, damaged, inappropriate, or exceed available display space. Tied quilts or cheater blocks are not acceptable except in youth or non-judged categories.
- All quilts (unless otherwise indicated on the Entry Form) must fit the definition of “quilt:” Three (3) layers - backing, filler (batting or fabric) and top, stitched together.
- **All quilts must have a sleeve that is 4” deep and the width of the quilt.** The top of the sleeve must be sewn no more than 112” from the bottom of the quilt, even if that means the sleeve is in the middle of the design. **Quilts with improper sleeve placement or without sleeves will be rejected. Wall hangings or quilts less than 120” perimeter may be pinned to sheeting or hung with sleeve.**
- **Art quilts must be delivered with a wooden or metal bar ready to be inserted into the quilt sleeve.** The rod must have a ¼” hole drilled ¼” from both the top and ¼” from the end of the bar. The sleeve must be shorter than the overall quilt width, so from the back, the rod and hole are easily accessible to hang the quilt. The bar must not be visible from the front of the quilt. The bar must be clearly labeled with the quilt name, quilter’s name, and phone number. If desired, a bottom sleeve and labeled bar may be used, but it is not necessary. **Quilts not meeting the above requirements may not be hung in the show.**

- Each entry must have a legible fabric label with the quilter’s name, which must be basted preferably to the back lower left corner of the quilt, and to the inside of other quilted items. Pin the Quilt Identification Tag over the label, right side down.
- All items must remain on display until the show closes on Saturday, April 18, 2026 at 3:00 pm. Quilts must be picked up during designated pick-up time slots or through arranged shipping.
- Evergreen Quilters Guild does not handle the sale of any items or collect commissions.
- Items entered in previous Evergreen Quilt Shows will not be accepted.
